









Barn Owl Nest Box on Maryland Marsh





Nest Box Site Selection Criteria


- 1. Presence of roosting owls
 - 2. Historical nesting site
- 3. Proximity to historical nesting site
 - 4. Suitable habitat



Nest Box Project 1988-2000

Prince George's – 25 boxes (approx. 200 to 250 fledged)

St. Mary's – 4 boxes (0 fledged)



Anne Arundel – 2 boxes (approx. 12 fledged)

Calvert – 19 boxes (26 fledged)

> 2000 – 2012 Little to no nesting




2012 Calvert County Citizen Involvement

St. Mary's – 2 boxes (no nesting)





Anne Arundel – 1 box (no nesting)
